




INTRODUCTION:

Thank you for purchasing the 2021-2024 Chevrolet Tahoe D-Pillar wedge mount kit.

D-Pillar wedge features include:

- Simple, adhesive-based install
- Mount up to 6, 3" mpower quick-mount fascia lights
- Flexible mounting configurations
- Increased rear facing, perimeter lighting solution

The D-Pillar wedge is a mounting solution for the 3" mpower® Fascia Light. The mpower® Fascia Light features include:

- 3" Quick Mount is compatible with this bracket design
- Collaboration with Dow Corning® to develop ClearDuty™ optical design
- Greater resistance to gravel pitting, scratching, or cracking
- Improved sealing to prevent water from entering light
- Higher UV and thermal stability to prevent lens from yellowing over time

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- 1. Remove the interior D-pillar panel to access the area behind the exterior D-pillar moulding. Removing the entire D-pillar assembly is recommended for wire routing. Consult a Chevrolet service center for best disassembly method.
- 2. Refer to the diagram shown in **Fig. 1** for recommended wedge positions along the D-pillar. Mark each position in the locations shown.

NOTE: Ensure the upper wedge is within the corner of the D-pillar as shown.

- 3. Before installing the wedges, ensure the driver side (LH) and passenger side (RH) wedges are separated. An identifier is located on the inside surface of each wedge, as shown in **Fig. 2**.
- 4. Hold the appropriate D-pillar wedge in position and mark the wire hole location. Repeat for each desired position on both the driver and passenger sides.
- 5. Using a 7/16" drill bit, drill out the wire holes at each marked location.
- 6. Using the provided alcohol wipe, clean the mounting surface of the wedge. Once dry, remove the white liner from the provided adhesive and carefully apply to the wedge surface, as shown in **Fig. 3**. Apply pressure for 30 seconds to ensure proper adhesion.
- 7. With the provided alcohol wipe, clean the surface of the D-pillar where the wedge will be applied.
- 8. With the D-pillar wedge in hand, remove the red liner on the wedge adhesive and carefully position the wedge on the D-pillar by holding it perpendicular to the D-pillar

surface and positioning the bottom edge of the wedge on the mark that was previously made, as shown in **Fig. 4**.

- 9. Pivot the wedge on its bottom edge towards the D-pillar surface while lining up the wedge in the D-pillar feature. Once fully seated, apply firm pressure on the wedge for 30 seconds to ensure proper adhesion.
- 10. **OPTIONAL**: Screws are provided and may be installed if desired, as shown in **Fig. 5**. However, they are not required. Ensure the area behind each wedge is free of obstructions prior to fastening with screws.



- 11. Route the required wire harnesses to each mounting location.
- 12.Connect a 3" quick-mount mpower light to the wire harness.
- 13. While feeding the wire harness back into the wire hole in the D-pillar, attach the light to the mounted wedge, as shown in **Fig. 6**. Ensure the surface of the wedge is clean using the provided alcohol wipe. Apply pressure for 30 seconds to ensure proper adhesion.
- 14.Repeat steps 6 13 for each D-pillar wedge on both the driver (LH) and passenger (RH) sides.
- 15.**Fig. 7** shows the fully installed D-pillar wedge assembly. 16.Test to ensure proper functionality.

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Allow <u>72 hours</u> for the adhesive to fully cure. Avoid wet conditions and high pressure spray until fully cure.
